IMPORTANT INFORMATION APPLICABLE TO BOTH PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOGRAPHY

This show will be professionally photographed and professionally video recorded. Other commercial photography or video recording or photography or video recording from a tripod mounted camera, or any photographing or video recording of entire classes of dogs will NOT be permitted.

Submission of an entry form and/or physical presence on the show grounds shall constitute both implied and real consent for both the handler and their dog to be photographed and/or video recorded.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote and otherwise exploit these events are vested in the FBDCA or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds, at any time while these events are in progress, do by attending these events or participating therein, grant the club the right to photograph, televise, video tape, audio tape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. Commercial photography and video recording, photography and video recording from a tripod mounted camera, or any photographing or video recording of entire classes of dogs shall require permission in advance, and in writing from the club. Photographs and/or video recordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strictly prohibited.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 6:00 am, Monday, October 5, 2015. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following close of show on Friday, October 9, 2015.

Damage to hotel rooms or grounds will be considered 'impairing a club's ability to retain a site,' and will be grounds for an Event Hearing in accordance with AKC's Dealing with Misconduct Regulations.

No puppies under the age of six (6) months, except those participating in the 4-6 Mo Beginner Puppy Competition, may be on the grounds.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Show Secretary is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition!

JUDGE: Ms Cindy Stansell

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

Entry Fee: \$25.00 (including AKC recording fee of \$2.00 for each dog. These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.)

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, September 16, 2015 at Superintendent's office.

NATIONAL AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.



“DON'T FORGET TO CHECK THE OWNER-HANDLED BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF ENTERING THIS COMPETITION.”



All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner*. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years.*

If ELIGIBLE dog wins award indicated by ✓ at the top it eliminates those marked with an X.

VETERAN DOG CLASS (9 Yrs & Under 11 Yrs) - A Class for Dogs nine (9) years & under eleven (11) years.

VETERAN DOG CLASS (11 Yrs & Older) - A Class for Dogs eleven (11) years & older.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS (7 Yrs & Under 9 Yrs) - A Class for Bitches seven (7) years & under nine (9) years.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS (9 Yrs & Under 11 Yrs) - A Class for Bitches nine (9) years & under eleven (11) years.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS (11 Yrs & Older) - A Class for Bitches eleven (11) years & older.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.
